**Question:** How Many Scouts *does* it take, to walk a little old lady across the street?

Uniform is preferred (minus sashes) or as an alternative activity dress with neckerchief may be worn.

### Special Instructions:

The route is 4 klms in length. It is important that all groups participating have sufficient adult leadership to allow younger children to break off from the parade safely should they be unable to walk the entire route. Leaders should have a game plan in this event. **There is a potential for small groups to meet the entry as it walks along and join the procession.**

If you can, join the parade on the Halifax side so we have a maximum number of participants when we reach the reviewing stand at the bridge plaza on the Dartmouth side of the MacDonald Bridge

Bring water with you! Remember '*BE PREPARED*'

The parade will form on Novalea Drive in Halifax beginning on Novalea Drive at Dartmouth Street travelling south along Gottingen Street, left on North Street and across the Macdonald Bridge. The reviewing stand will be at the Macdonald Bridge toll plaza and the parade will then exit right on Wyse Road, left on Alderney Drive to the corner of Alderney Drive and Ochterlony Street. It will then travel up Ochterlony Street finishing at the corner of Ochterlony Street and Pine Street. **(This is very close to Sullivan's pond and a good place to meet parents etc...)**
